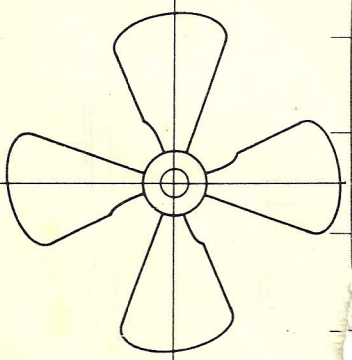
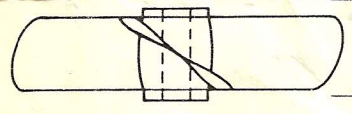
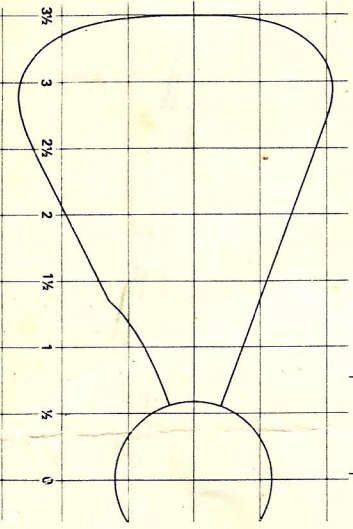


A portion of the drawing for a propeller from the Weymouth Iron Works in East Weymouth, Massachusetts in 1881. The log of the WEYMOUTH states:

Lost propeller while Blue Whale in tow - April 17th, 1881. Records show that a new propeller was cast at the Iron Works in April 1881 and that it was fitted up on the WEYMOUTH at low tide, the WEYMOUTH being purposely beached on Paddocks Island at the time. Work took one tide . . . labor costs for three men and one boy - \$5.30!
